Wessex Orchid Societ y Guidelines for Competition Plants

Cattleya Alliance (Laeliinae) Species / Hybrid Includes: Cattleya, Laelia, Sophronitis, Brassavola, Barkeria, Broughtonia, Encyclia, Epidendrum, Leptotes

Cymbidium includes: Cymbidium, Ansellia, Cymbidiella

Oncidium Alliance includes: Ada, Brassia, Cochlioda, Comparettia, Lockhartia, Miltonia, Miltoniopsis, Odontoglossum, Oncidium, Rodriguezia, Rossioglossum, Trichopilia, and hybrids there between

Paphiopedilum / Phragmipedium includes: Cypripedium, Paphiopedilum, Phragmipedium, Selenipedium

Ple urothallid inc ludes: Dracula, Dryadella, Lepanthes, Lepanthopsis, Masdevallia, Octomeria, Pleurothallis, Restrepia, Stelis

Phalaenops is includes: Phalaenopsis, Doritis, Kingidium, Sarcochilus, Trichoglottis

Vanda & Allie d includes: Vanda, Vandopsis, Aerangis, Aerides, Angraecum, Arachnis, Ascocentrum, Neofinetia, Renanthera, Rhyncostylis

Coelogyninae includes: Coelogyne, Dendrochilum, Pholidota, Pleione
